- Assist in tracking inventory of pallets and packaging materials. Load and unload trucks containing pallets and/or finished product.
- Review and complete various forms and documents.
- Ensures that problems, errors and/or defects that surface in regard to products, documentation, procedures or materials are promptly brought to attention for correction.
- Must be flexible and willing to work in other areas as needed. Must be able to work overtime, weekends and holidays as necessary.
