Wastewater Operator Position

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Operate and monitor wastewater treatment processes and equipment.
- Perform routine inspections, maintenance, and repairs of pumps, motors, valves, generators, and related equipment.
- Collect samples and conduct laboratory testing as required.
